

The Instructional Design Planning: How to Request an Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR) from the Central Processing System (CPS)

1. Project Context – Higher Ed., Business, Government

- The purpose of this course is to teach employees who work in financial aid to request an ISIR from CPS.
- The end objective is for the university to request a student's ISIR transaction that was not automatically sent to the school.

Dick and Carey's instructional systems design model – Nine components in the system working together toward a defined goal.

5. Course Learning Objectives and Strategy

1. Identify instructional goals – Request an Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR) from the Central Processing System (CPS)
2. Conduct Instructional Analysis – FA Counselors' personal learning preference. Hands-on, Auditory, Visual, etc.
3. Analyze learners and contexts – Interview/question knowledge of the ISIR and CPS system
4. Write performance objectives – The goal is to increase opportunities for students in higher education by obtaining their ISIR for the purposes of awarding financial aid.
5. Develop assessment instruments – scenarios in requesting the ISIR from CPS
6. Develop instructional design – Blue print of step by step instructions
7. Develop and select instructional material(s) – Computer, Banner access, CPS access, student information, token, Canva video of instructions.
8. Design and conduct formative evaluation of instruction – Group trial and interviews with the participants.
9. Design and conduct summative evaluation – Desired output? Did we receive the students' ISIR in our report?
10. Revise Instructions throughout the process
